

Sound of speed



The key to adding distance to your game could be just a swish away

Assuming you're making correct contact with the ball, the more clubhead speed you have, the further your shots will travel. However, a lot of players, and women in particular, don't know

how much speed they need in their swing. Here is an easy drill you can do at home or at the range to help quicken the tempo. You don't need a ball for this – just your driver and a little space.



Speed trigger

Flip the driver over, take your normal grip near where the shaft meets the clubhead. Take a few swings of the club and listen to the swish sound, the louder the swish, the further the ball will travel. This is the sound you want to hear next time you tee one up at the course.
